■ No dental floss	■ No wipes (baby/bath), TP ONLY!



Good Cleaning Agents: vinegar, baking soda, lemon juice, Borax, Dawn clear dish soap, eucalyptus oil; plant-based, phosphate-free, and bleach-free store-bought products.
